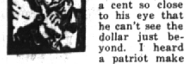

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that at a special election to be held at the City Office Building, in said City of Bloomfield Hills, on Monday the 23rd day of October, 1939, the following question will be submitted to you:

Do you favor the confirming of an ordinance and franchise to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, granting permission to erect, construct, lay, operate and maintain, within the CITY OF BLOOMFIELD HILLS, all needed and proper poles, towers, mains, wires, pipes, conduits and other apparatus requisite for the transmission and distribution of electricity for public and private use, subject however, to all conditions and restrictions of said ordinance and franchise, as presented to the City Commission of said City, held on Tuesday the 12th day of September, 1939.

A copy of said ordinance and franchise is on file with the City Clerk, and it is open to the inspection of the electors of said City.

At said election the form of ballot will be as follows: Confirming grant of ordinance and franchise to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, for the purpose of the erection, construction and maintenance of towers, poles, mains, wires, pipes, conduits, apparatus, etc., requisite for the transmission and distribution of electricity for public and private use.

Notice is hereby given that any person wishing to vote at this election must be registered on or before Saturday the 14th day of October, 1939, at 5:00 P. M.

Any person who is a citizen of the United States, 21 years of age, will have resided in the City of Bloomfield Hills twenty days and in the State of Michigan six months prior to the date of election, may register by calling at the City Clerk's office in the Municipal Building on or before Saturday, October 14th, 1939, between the hours of 8 o'clock A. M. and 5 o'clock P. M. The City Clerk's office will be open to receive registrations on Tuesday, October 3rd, 1939, between the hours of 8 o'clock A. M. and 8 o'clock P. M.
