ORDINANCE NUMBER 285  
City of Birmingham

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 224 WHICH RELATES TO THE INITIAL LICENSING OF NEW MERCANTILE ESTABLISHMENTS.

The City of Birmingham Ordinance: That Section 8 of Ordinance No. 285 be amended to read as follows:

Section 8. Licensees issued under this ordinance during the last 6 months of the City fiscal year shall exhibit the license on the business premises during the amount of such tax but not exceeding one-half of the amount of license fee paid, provided the license holder present the paid receipt for said license fee to the City Treasurer and pay the difference, if any, before said license fee is refunded. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after the passage and upon publication thereof.

**Hunters May Carry Guns Into Canada**  
No difficulty will be experienced by American sportsmen in taking their own guns and a "reasonable amount" of ammunition on Canadian hunting expeditions this fall, according to advice received by Grand Trunk-Canadian National Railways' officers from Canadian Government officials. The new regulations provide that American sportsmen make application either to the Canadian Commissioner of Customs or Commissioner, Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Ottawa, for credentials, and a statement of duration of stay in Canada as well as of the Canadian firearms to be brought in. Revolvers, however, will not be admitted except for Canadian citizens. Firearms so granted, will be sent to the Canadian port of entry and sportsmen advised to claim permits at border points indicated.
