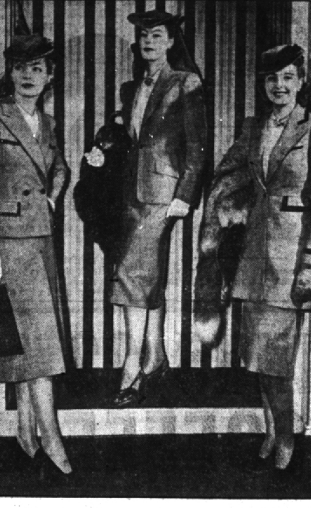
The guest V. F. W. speaker, in his talk, stated that "We as Veterans of Foreign Wars are not individuals must put thumbs down on 'alien isms'. To deny the right of free speech to those who preach the doctrine of Hitler, Stalin and Mussolini would be to violate the very principles of Americanism, for our Constitution says that all people of this country may have free speech and free thought, freedom of worship and freedom of assembly."

But he also stated that "We are opposed to these other theories of government. In Germany, Italy and Russia all individual rights are destroyed. So when Communism, Nazism and Fascism come knocking at our doors and tries to sell us as American citizens another form of government, let's compare the results of Americanism with the results of other governments which are opposed to our democracy, and there is our answer."
