There are few people who will forget the May of 1939 when the submarine Sculpin went to the bottom in a routine test dive and did not come up again.

The ensuing feverish activity was duly reported by radio and newspaper and the World held its breath while contact was made with the crippled submarine. The outlook was a gloomy one, for the Sculpin lay 243 feet below the surface. The crew of how the survivors of the crew reached the surface makes an unbelievable story.

It is told in detail by Commander Edward Elberg in Men Under the Sea. This new book by the author is "On the Bottom" and "Bigboats" is a collection of stories about deep-sea diving, of hair-raising adventures, in sunken wrecks many feet below the surface.

Flowering Earth, by Donald Culross Peattie. Beautifully written explanations of some of nature's mysterious processes. Beginning with the first appearance of plant life on the earth, it discusses the story of plant life in an amusing and original way.
