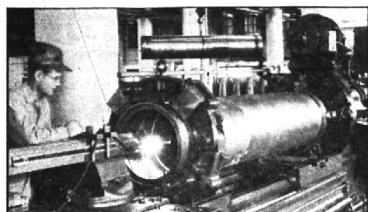
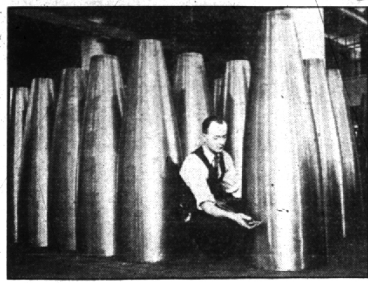

Deadliest Torpedoes in the Making



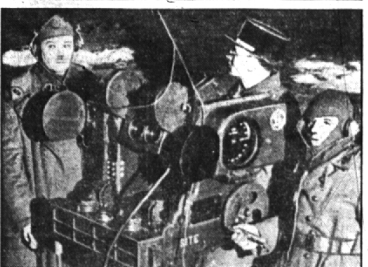
The United States government is expanding its facilities for making the world's deadliest ammunition—ultra-modern torpedoes. More than 300 skilled craftsmen are already at work in the renovated plant at Alexandria, Va., others are being added daily. Top photo shows a machinist-inspector measuring new, finished torpedo near sections, some parts of which must be accurate to within 1/10,000 of an inch. Bottom photo shows a 4 1/2 ton torpedo being turned in size on a huge lathe. The government has already spent \$2,500,000 on the Virginia plant, one of two such in the country.

Breeder Calls Catalo a Super Cow



Mounful Jumbo, the touring catalo, is a cross between a cow and a bison. The animal was bred on Colville, Wash., ranch by Leonard C. Wilson, in wagon, who has driven 9000 miles in 22 states to acquaint cattlemen with these catalo qualities: (1) weighs 2100, but can easily pull a 2000-pound load; (2) lives 25-30 years, twice as long as cattle; (3) gives rich milk, averaging 6 1/2 per cent butterfat; (4) more disease free. Unlike bull dog, most catalos have no horns.
