Former Soldiers Are Sought for Army Reserve

CHICAGO—Voluntary continuation of their membership in the Regular Army is made possible for thousands of former soldiers returning each year to civil life by enlistment in the Regular Army Reserve, it was pointed out today by Lieut. General Stanley H. Ford, Commander of the Sixth Corps Area.

Until recently these trained men, many of them highly qualified in aviation, automotive, radio and other work essential to the military service, have had no opportunity to remain in official contact with the Army after accepting their honorable discharge.

"The Army is anxious to contact former soldiers under 35 years of age who have served at least one year in the Regular Army and who were honorably discharged. Their marital status will not in any way prevent them from being eligible. These former soldiers are paid at the rate of \$24 a year," General Ford concluded.

Enlistment in the Regular Army Reserve may be accomplished by eligible former Regular Army men at any of the 54 recruiting stations now established in principal cities of Illinois, Michigan and Wisconsin.

LANSING—Future "adjustments" of sales tax claims against merchants will be granted only after a full and open hearing of the circumstances involved and not by the Board of Equalization considered and that is as to whether or not the taxpayer has been properly assessed," it was announced by Herbert J. Equisition, Managing Director of the State Board of Tax Administration.
