Permit in a statement properly signed and dated and such statement shall have the force of a Certificate of Occupancy.

The Building Inspector may issue a Temporary Certificate of Occupancy for a part of a building prior to the completion of the entire building, but such temporary Certificate shall not remain in farce for a period in excess of six (6) months nor more than five (5) days after the completion of the building ready for occupancy.

SECTION X-ENFORCEMENT

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be administered by the Building Inspector, who, shall be appointed by the Township Board for such term and subject to such conditions and at such rate of compensation as said Board shall determine; and the duty of enforcement hereof shall rest with such administrative official or officials as shall be author-

SECTION XI-PENALTIES

Any firm, corporation or person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for each offense, or shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for a period of not to exceed ninety (90) days for each offense, or may be both fined and imprisoned, as provided herein. Any building which is erected, altered or converted or any use of land which is begun or changed subsequent to the time of passage of this Ordinance and in violation of any of the provisions thereof is hereby declared a nuisance per se. The Building Inspector, the Legislative Body of the Township, the Board of Appeals or any court having jurisdiction shall order such nuisance abated and the owner or agent in charge of such building or land shall be adjudged guilty of maintaining a nuisance per se. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense. The rights and remedies provided herein are cumulative and in addition to all other remedies provided by law.

· SECTION XII—AMENDMENTS

In the manner prescribed by Act No. 302 of the Public Acts of Michigan for 1937 as amended, the Township Board may from time to time on petition amend, supplement or change the boundaries of said District and on its own motion or petition may amend or supplement regulations hereinafter established. Whenever the owners of fifty per cent (50°) or more of the frontage in any zone or part thereof shall present to the Township Board a petition in writing, duly signed and which shall have been acknowledged by each of said petitioners substantially in accordance with the provisions for the acknowledgment of deeds, requesting an amendment, supplement, change or repeal of the regulations prescribed for such zone or part thereof, it shall be the duty of the Township Board to refer the petition to the Planning Board for their recommendations and to vote upon said petition within sixty (60) days after the filing of the same by the petitioners with the Township Board. If any area, is hereafter transferred to another zone by a change in zone boundaries by an amendment as above provided, the provisions of this Ordinance, relating to buildings or uses of buildings or land existing at the time of passage of this Ordinance shall apply to buildings or uses of buildings or land existing at the time of passage of

SECTION XIII-INTERPRETATION; BURPOSE

SECTION XIII—INTERPRETATION; RURPOSE

In interpreting and applying the provisions of this Ordinance, they shall be held to be the minimum requirements adopted for the promotion of the public health, safety, comfort, convenience, prosperity and general welfare. It is not intended by this Ordinance to repeal, abrogate, annul or in any way to impair or interfere with any existing and unrepealed provision of law or Ordinance or any rules, regulations or permits previously adopted or issued pursuant to law relating to the use of buildings or land; provided, however, that where this Ordinance imposes a greater restriction upon the use of buildings or structures or land or upon the height, area or size of buildings or requires larger yards, courts or other open spaces than are imposed or required by such existing provision of law or Ordinance or by such rules, regulations or permits, the provisions of this Ordinance shall control. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION XIV—VALIDITY


Should any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance be de-clared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.

SECTION XV-EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance is ordered to take effect as soon as a public hearing is held thereon in accordance with Section 5, Act 69 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan for the year 1939.
