

### 1-Year Enlistments No Longer Taken

Several boys under the age of 21 have inquired of The Eccentric whether they can enlist now for their year's training and "get it over with."

Col. J. L. Bachus, Detroit, Army Recruiting officer for Michigan, advised The Eccentric that one-year enlistments were discontinued at 10 p. m., Tuesday, and that all regular enlistments are now for three years.

However, he voiced the opinion that there may be National Guard or Naval Reserve units which will take three- or four-year enlistments, but where only one-year of full training is contemplated at this time.

Information on the Army, Navy, Marine, Coast Guard and Air Corps can be secured at various offices in the Federal Building, Detroit.

"We are taking all the air cadets we can get," Col. Bachus declared. "These men must be from 20 to 27 years of age, and have at least two years of college training."
