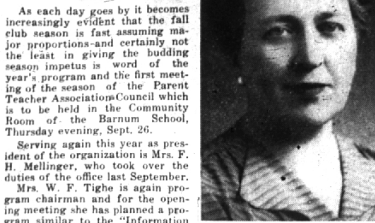


Birmingham Parent-Teacher Association Outlines Plans for Coming Year
