### "Rumors About Jesus"

(Following is the substance of a sermon given last Sunday in the Birmingham First Presbyterian Church, by its pastor, Rev. W. Glen Harris.)

"When they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem." (John 12:12)

Many people live on the strength of the rumors they hear. Propaganda has become very effective instrument in modern civilization. Rumor has become so effective that the truth is increasingly difficult to determine. The present program of planned propaganda more and more determines the destiny of man. It is interesting to observe that the flowing days of Christ's earthly ministry were shrouded with the designs of propaganda, rumor and hearsay.

The ancient and venerable feast of the Passover was at hand. The fame of Jesus had touched the life of all people who had any semblance of religious responsibility. The pilgrims who had traveled from far and near congregated in groups, and the question that dominated all thought and conversation: "Will he come to the feast?" There arose a murmur, nervously apprehensive lest he absent himself as he had done the previous year. At the appointed time,

rule He did not count popular attention. Here, on the occasion, he saw his making a public entry into Jerusalem, and he did not immerse crowd of people, and causing the Pharisees to say, "Behold the world is gone after Him."

Many rumors developed during the public feasts, events of Christ's last days. Some of those rumors are worthy of our consideration today, almost twenty centuries later.

Man's religion affects his actions. In those days it was rumored that Jesus openly advocated the principle that the man of religion actually has some influence upon the way he does. Jesus openly taught and the reason for this was that the people of that day had not accepted a thought and their general resentment caused it to be received at first as a rumor. Men alter and color the things that they perceive to harmonize with the things that they want to hear. They discount the things that are objectionable and glorify anything that appears in their favor.

In those days it was rumored that Jesus was King of the Jews. He was placed upon the cross, and it was said that he died for the people. Upon the basis of this interpretation of a fact, the whole of religious, local, temporal and eternal life, they suggested that in the due course of time His people would rule the world.

The world has well witnessed the tragedy of such interpretations of fact. We are willing to give a little money to missions, or to send out our missionaries to live in our own borders, to have a little religion, but we send our missionaries to live in other countries, to understand that God was one, first, and He can never be two.
