

New Showroom Of Hudson Agency to Open Saturday

Grand opening of the new Hudson motor showroom at 666 South Woodward avenue will be held Saturday. It was announced today by Claude E. Mosher, owner of the Birmingham Motor Sales, Inc. The public is invited to inspect the showroom recently purchased by Mosher, and to see the new 1942 Hudson Drive-Master automobiles which will be on display.

Former Showroom Nearby.
For several years, Mosher has been located several hundred feet to the south, but moved when he purchased the present salesroom, where he will be better able to serve his customers.

Mosher is one of Birmingham's oldest auto dealers in point of service, and says he has been in business here continuously longer than any other. He came here in 1926, and has been Hudson dealer since 1931. During the same period, his has been the official AAA garage. He is completely equipped to give all types of garage service, including bumping, painting, frame straightening, general repairs and emergency road service.

Mosher was born in Armada and earned for 11 years after finishing high school. His first experience in the automobile business was in Flint, where he sold Buicks for the branch agency for six months before opening his first garage here in 1926. (He still owns the farm.)

Started in Small Garage.
He started out with a small garage on Pierce street, then moved to a larger location on West Maple and finally went to his present location on South Woodward. Before 1932 he sold Studebaker cars.

During the World War, Claude served with the Marines, and spent most of his time in the West Indies where the Marines' principal job was to keep saboteurs from burning the sugar cane fields. The only battle he said he'll tell you today, was one fought in a Cuban cafe.

Mr. Mosher is an accomplished salesman, and has won several trips as prizes. Only this spring, he and Mrs. Mosher won a trip to Miami, Fla., with all expenses paid.

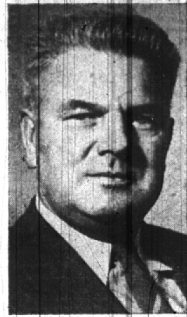
