Defertment Goes to Rural Labor
BIRMINGHAM — What a lot of county farmers can do to help assure themselves a labor supply throughout the year, the Agricultural Service System has outlined this week. The director of the Service System has asked for all local draft boards to give special consideration to deferment of men needed in agricultural production. In addition, the WPA is making special effort to supply demands for farm labor.

When the selective service questionnaire is received, ask deferment in Class 2, occupation deferment; or, if there are dependents, Class 3, dependency.

The employer or dependent should submit to the local draft board Form 42 or a letter properly addressed and presented to the registrant should also present the reasons for requesting deferment. The registrant should also present the employer or dependent's consent by letter if necessary, in addition to the statement in the questionnaire.

(3) If the local board does not grant the requested deferment, the case may be appealed through the board of appeals by the registrant, by the persons who signed Form 42, by the employer or dependent, or by the state director of the selective service. A copy of the appeal agent is attached to each local board; and he will assist in filing appeals.
