"Idea was the third likelihood offered by Slosson. "Although this has been expected for some time, it will probably appear the clear winner of being," he said. "This, when it comes, however, will come in stages, each having a definite bearing on the general public interest."

"An increase in the naval attack, followed by the intensifying of the submarine and torpedo attacks, will finally lead to an actual invasion by land forces, probably by the order of procedure which only may be the large, dominant cities, but more likely destroyed ports, than any access of the coast."

Naval operations, beginning with Indo-China, and getting the attention of the British forces here and there, the invaders would form a bridgehead at the expense of their own hold."

"The southern ports of France will be the base for the direct invasion through the newly defended waters of Ireland, and Norway will be used for an invasion of the north ports of Scotland.
