DRIVE 9-Point Economy Program Suggested

LANING—A program which would mean retirement of Michigan's \$27,000,000 floating debt within three years, greatly improving the financial position of the state, was presented here Tuesday by the Legislature.

Legislators and taxpayers, chairman of the state finance committee, welcomed the assembled taxpayers and expressed the hope that their cooperation with the legislature would be continued.

The report dealt with the high cost of collecting taxes, and suggested a number of ways in which the state could save approximately \$1,800,000 and \$3,000,000 annually.

The report set forth a nine-point program for the consideration of the legislature.
