

Dr. Schuman Talks Union With Britain

A new world order based on the establishment of an international confederation of English-speaking nations was a suggestion presented to a group of 300 citizens at the University of Michigan last night.

The speaker was Dr. Frederick L. Schuman, professor of government at Williams College, who spoke at the Community House last Monday night. This lecture was one in the series now being sponsored by the Community House.

"The Diplomacy of Nemesia," the title of his talk, is also the name of his latest book, which went on sale the very day of his visit to Birmingham. This noted foreign affairs commentator was introduced to the large audience by John W. Gillette of Wing Lake road, a Williams graduate in 1919. A director which was given directly before this talk at the Community House was attended by several Williams College alumni and other interested friends, together with Charles H. Shain, general chairman.

"The highest of the Schuman address was the stressing of the organization of the world after the war. The only way that the United States now has, is that of seeing the downfall of militaristic Germany. We don't especially care to see the victory of England, China, or Greece. It is merely the fact that we desire the military defeat of Hitler," he said.

"There are only two ways which we can keep out of this war. In the end it will be the President of the United States or the people of this republic who will get us into war. It will be either Hitler, Mussolini, and that man in Tokio, who don't care to tear down the world, that they will not hesitate," he continued.

While in the light of events today, they would do all of us, there can be no peace. And we have everything to fear if Germany wins this war.

"Twenty years ago thousands of Americans went to Europe to fight and to 'make the world safe for democracy.'" Many have said that they died in vain, but I do not think so. They were willing to pay the price of precious freedom. The people of this country are now finding out how great a price that is.

The basic cause of the world's trouble today, as always, is the everlasting conflict between the rich and the poor. The poor are being in chains by the rich, and the rich are afraid of the poor. Perhaps in the settlement which will have to be made after this war, this problem can be taken care of.

A problem of today lies in the Leon Blum, the Chamberlains, and the Laval of America. I fear Hitler, and so do I fear every other person who loves and treasures freedom."

Although Germany fears and hates Russia, she will take no steps to arouse friction with the "good neighbor to the east," he declared. When and if England is defeated, the necessary steps will be of course, he taken. Dr. Schuman also believes that Russia will be the necessary step to bring matters to a decisive issue. He felt that England was going down. And who would be the other step in when America is going into it anyway? Many Americans could take a lesson from Joe," the speaker declared.

When asked a question as to the reason for Russia's concern over Bulgaria, Dr. Schuman said that if Germany was to hold this country under the yoke, and control the Straits then Russia's position would be very precarious.
