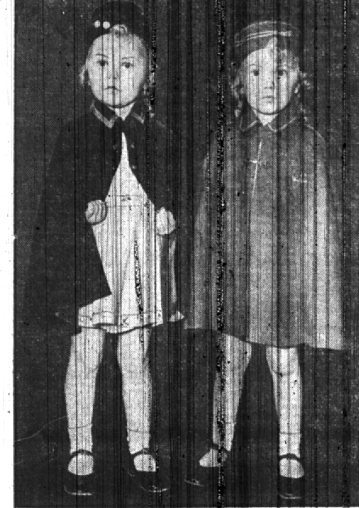
Local Dance Club To Have Party Jan. 25
