

Saturday Club Opens for 7th Year With 293 Members, a Large Increase

The Community House Saturday Club opened last Saturday, Jan. 12, for its seventh annual term of ten weeks, with a thruping registration of 293 members, approximately one-third higher than last year's initial day.

Mrs. Ralph H. Scheel, general chairman, announces the following additional figures compiled by Miss Peggy Allen, in charge of club records: Of the total registration, 160 were boys, 133 girls, Section I (Basium and Quanton) registered 112 members; Section

II (Adams, Pierce, Holy Name and outlying schools), 141 members.

By schools, the registration was divided as follows: Barnum, 64; Quanton, 48; Adams, 97; Pierce, 28; Holy Name, 10; outlying schools, 12. Activity choice gives the following: wood, 81; metal, 24; leather, 24; draughts, 49; chess, 9; painting, 23; clay, 15; weaving, 36.

Because of a misunderstanding on the part of some parents and children, Mrs. Scheel stated that the grades eligible for Saturday Club membership are 2A-B inclusive, refer to pupils at present in those grades; therefore, pupils who have been in 2B for the past semester cannot be eligible for the Community House Saturday Club in 1941. When the new semester starts next week, the present 2A's will be in the 3B and there will be no 2nd graders in the club.

Theodore (Pete) Czerkowski, Community House Saturday Club Director, wishes to remind all members to be prompt for their respective sections this Saturday; Section I, Barnum and Quanton, by 9 a. m. sharp; Section II, Adams, Pierce, Holy Name and outlying schools by 10 a. m. sharp. He also reminds that the 20-cent registration fee covers the whole ten weeks.
