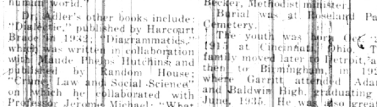

City to Get Gasoline At Wholesale Price

The City Commission approved Monday night a proposal to buy a 10,000-gallon tank to hold gasoline so that the City can take bids and get the lowest prices on full truck "train" loads of motor fuel. The same as the City has done in the past, the tank, costing \$500 would be paid for within nine months through the savings as the city's 45,000 gallons a year of city vehicles now draw from a 1,000-gallon tank at the city warehouse.
