

Three Teams Remain Bunched At Top of Softball League

All-Star Game Will Be Played Tuesday, July 29

Torrey Field, located on East Ruffner street, will be the scene of one of the most important softball games of the season next Wednesday evening, when Danner's Market, currently sporting an 11 game winning streak, will tangle with a third place Babcock-Salisbury by seven runs for any team in the league.

Should Babcock win, it would throw the first three squads Danner's, Bell's, and Babcock-Salisbury into one game apiece. Up to this writing these three teams are the only teams with a winning percentage in the standings.

While the merry battle for the top spot is going on, another hot four-team scramble is being waged for the fourth place berth.

At present, Mortimer's, last week's undisputed fourth place team, and Ladd's Service are jockeying on the thin margin of a few percentage points over Franklin and Stevenson's Service. Ladd's Service, by agreement of a majority of the managers, was given a 1.00 rating, but dropped below this by losing six Stevens Tuesday evening, 15-8. This was done because Ladd's team took over the old Holy Name Usher's team after eight straight defeats had been inflicted on the hapless church team.

MSCP also of late has been a derailed due to base hits, and capturing a victory of the current campaign. Other results during the week of the league, and starting Monday, games with this team will be canceled, unless the team should be reinstated in good standing before this time.

Developments during the past week failed to make any material change in the top three teams. However two defeats of Mortimer's at the hands of Danner's and Bell's left that team in danger of dropping that team into a second-division spot.

Of the leaders, Danner's added two more wins to its streak by winning from MSCP and Mortimer's, after fighting an uphill battle all the way to the end. Babcock-Salisbury, which had but one game during the week, notched its ninth victory in 12 starts by defeating Ladd's Service.

Bell's also had a very inactive week, ploughing Ladd's team unopposed.
