When there's a market for a million bushels of seed, it's a good idea to go into seed production.

The crop is the seed of Chenopodium, a perennial grass used in grass seed mixtures, especially for light soil, sandy areas and as a cover crop in sandy soil orchards.

R. R. Gaukler, of the college crops department, has prognosis for the future.

Seed was drilled in 28-inch rows in August, 1939. In fact, little was done with the fence except two spring and two fall cultivations.

Put Salt in Woods to Save Deer

NEWBERRY—Salt is saving the lives of hundreds of deer in the vicinity of Newberry these days.

Thousands of the animals, attracted

to highways for salt, have been killed this season by passing automobiles.

To keep deer off the roads, offers of salt have been made.

Department have distributed 650 pounds of salt in six-pound boxes along highways M-28, M-94 and M-77, stretching 10 miles back from the right-of-way.
