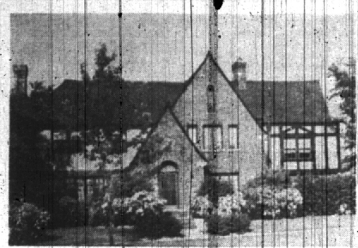

ZONING PROPOSITION

"Shall Act No. 302 of the Public Acts of 1937 permitting the township board in certain townships to provide for the establishment of the districts or zones in unincorporated areas within which the use of land and structures, the height, the area, the size and location of buildings may be regulated by township ordinance, and, within which districts, regulations shall be established for the light, ventilation, sanitation and protection of buildings, and within which districts the height of buildings may be regulated by ordinance, be adopted by a district bounded as follows:
