HONOR, Mich.—A fish-herding dog that can manage trout as well as his ancestors herds sheep is "worth as much as a man."

That is the opinion of Herman Galvin, caretaker of the competition department trout raising station east of here.

Sandy, a well-trained two-year-old that is part German shepherd and part collie, proved his worth last summer by killing 32 water snakes in one month and by driving off herring gulls and other predators from the rearing ponds.

When men with nets once failed to catch a big rainbow trout that by accident got into one of the ponds, it was the work of Sandy's little fingers, Sandy went on the job and in a few minutes had the fish in his pocket.

Sandy is making himself useful by driving fish into the pockets where they may be seized by hand. At this he is better than a herring gull, for he can get under low parts of the dam where a human being cannot go.

Sandy is in fact a fond of chasing fish for his own good. Last summer he had to be kept out of the ponds when because of too frequent duckings, often made to the amusement of tourists, he suffered a trout in rheumatism and mange.
