Like Dumplings? Here Are Recipes For Seven Delicious Kinds

The serving of dumplings at dinner usually means a thrill as well as a surprise. The part of one never knows whether it contains a well-baked apple, chestnut or even a jelly. There are many kinds of dumplings, plain dumplings, savory and dessert dumplings.

- 1 egg, 3 tablespoons milk, 1/4 cup flour, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/2 teaspoon baking powder. Beat the egg to light, add the milk and mix together. Add salt and baking powder and add the egg and milk to this to form a heavy batter. Add a little more milk if necessary. Drop by spoonfuls into hot gravy and cook 15 minutes without turning lid from steam.

- 1 egg, 1/4 cup apple or orange juice, 1/2 cup flour, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/2 teaspoon baking powder. Combine cornmeal, water, onion and salt. Steam 15 hours. Add eggs and parsley. Shape in small balls, roll in flour and cook two minutes in hot soup.

Widespread Effort To Reorganize State Governments

LANSING—Reorganization of state government on a business basis is becoming the order of the day not only in Michigan but in many other states, according to legislative reports received here. In Michigan the first step toward this end is the proposed McCallum-Neller bill for consolidation of the state's revenue collection. In addition to consolidated collection of state revenues, and financial control, more efficient purchasing and progressive reorganization of state departments, boards and commissions has been advocated.

Central Purchasing Many legislatures are considering reorganization of state's fiscal operations. Proposed include the consolidation of departments and bureaus to bring about better and less costly administration and the setting up of effective state budgeting and general accounting procedures. In California, legislation and constitutional amendments are being sought, providing for the organization of the state's fiscal operations, including tax collection, pre-audits and post-audits of expenditures, and the handling and investment of state funds. Complete reorganization of state government by statute and by constitutional amendment is being considered in Colorado, including the collection of revenue in the office of the State Treasurer. Idaho is calling for elimination of certain state boards and commissions to improve administrative efficiency. It is being recommended that certain departments of the government be brought under the creation of the office of central purchasing agents to coordinate and combine the purchases of various departments, and to "obtain for the state and the taxpayers a resultant lowering of costs," also is before the Iowa Legislature.

Movie Shows Life In CCC Camps

MUNISING—Many young men along the Atlantic seaboard and in the north central states are going to get their first impression of what life is like in a CCC camp from a motion picture filmed in a scenic state game area, east here. Taken by Walter F. Hastings, staff photographer of the conservation department, the picture traces the enrollment of an unemployed Detroit youth of 19, oldest in a family of six, to his work in the north woods in winter. The film will be widely used by the CCC organization to show the advantages of enrollment in the Civilian Conservation Corps, in a reorganizing campaign to keep CCC camps at full strength.
