

Smith St. Group Calls for Action To Relieve Dust

This year's early but dry spring has turned many of Birmingham's streets into minor "dustbowls" and a heavy demand has resulted for dust control. In some cases, the cost is privately borne. Smith street residents said they were "eating" dust at a hearing last Monday night, determining the advisability of improving the street.

Several women present "moaned" when their leaders asked whether Commissioner's OK, it would take about a month before action could start. "We have to wait longer? I'm just eating dust!" Mrs. Anna Harris, 1333 Smith, declared.

Another said: "It's just plain dust but it's so bad, but it's mixed up with last year's dirt and it settles about an inch thick."

Mrs. Pierce E. Ryan, who lives at Smith and Cummings said the dust threatened to ruin their garage. The word showed cheap oil on Smith, rather than rebuilding plus oil on Cummings.

Questionnaires were sent to all of the blocks from Woodward to the east. Most replies were almost all favorable.

The improvement consists of tearing up the street and laying six inches of gravel over new true grade soil. Application of asphalt oil on steel fiber, is sufficient for four years.

would exceed 25 per cent of the original cost.

The cost was estimated at about a front foot per yard.

To give immediate relief from dust, City Manager G. G. Egbert suggested application of light oil on steel fiber to the street surface to start work later when convenient. In any event, taxpayers on the street may have a portion of the cost deducted when the project can start, it was said. The cost per lot, estimated at about \$20, can be divided into five yearly payments.

It will be received before work starts was not made clear at the meeting Monday night.

The parting word at the hearing ended was: "Hope to raise."
