Confusion Natural In A Democracy

The state of mind of the American people regarding our nation's part and place in this European war is, of course, confused and somewhat perplexed... There is no more confusion and perplexity about this war business than there is about most of our purely domestic issues...

Will Live

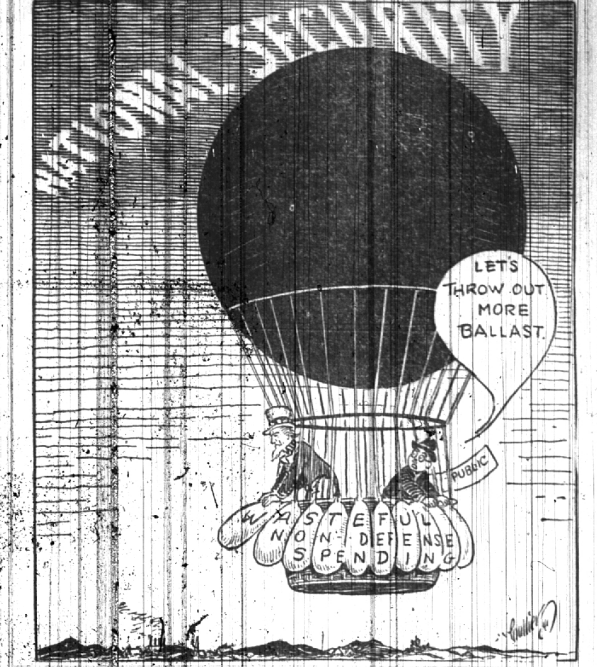
By the combined power of Will Live Italy and Germany, should not be considered as a "defeat" for Greece... The Greek Republic, throughout the world, holds its head high.
