Deepest Well Yields Gas But No Oil

BAY CITY.—Although drilling operations stopped recently at 10,445 feet the Bateson oil well in the Gulf Refining company near Kawkaulin rates as the deepest well east of the Mississippi river, according to officials of the conservation department geology division said.

The previous record for deep drilling in Michigan was 9,976 feet at the Bates No. 1 drilled by the Newby Oil and Gas Company south of White Cloud in Newaygo county.

The Bateson well at Kawkaulin is the first in the state to produce gas abundantly in the "salt section" about 7,774 feet below the surface. Only traces of gas and oil had been found previously in the Salina formation in widely scattered wells throughout the state. The Bateson well was capable of producing more than eight million cubic feet of gas a day, oil operators estimated all the "salt section" was drilled.

City Has Enough Parks, Is Decision

The City Commission was given opportunity Monday night to purchase another parcel of park property along the River Rouge, east of the north intersection of Woodward and Reuter, but rejected the offer on the grounds that the City already has large tracts of undeveloped park lands.

Submitted by J. H. Sheridan, the proposal would have given the land to the City for \$500, with adjoining property owners paying another \$500. The nearby residents are interested in the area because of the "recreation" of their property values.

Jack Moore Catches 'Grandpappy' Pike
Jack Moore, City streamer, caught the "grandpappy" all fish in Wing Lake—a nine pound pike. Thursday afternoon, Wing Lake is the smallest in the county and his catch was one of the largest ever taken there.
