The contest was very close, but Miss Moore's room was the winner. The prize was given to the home room with the highest percentage of Booster subscribers.

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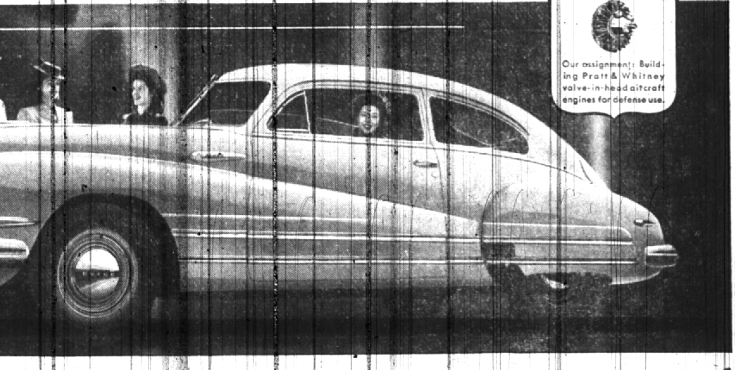
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
