## Must Get Permission To Cut Yule Trees

LANSING.—All persons wishing to cut, remove or transport Christmas trees, evergreen boughs and other decorative materials within the State of Michigan are required to obtain a permit from the State Game Commission. The permit is valid for one year and must be obtained before the tree is cut or removed.

The State Game Commission is responsible for the regulation and control of the game and fish resources of the state. It is required to issue permits for the cutting and removal of Christmas trees and evergreen boughs.
