



Every family owns a share of Birmingham's Community House.



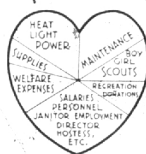
The House has proved its right to be called the "Heart of Birmingham."

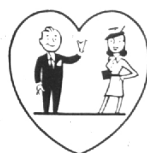

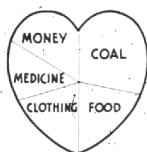
## 1942 ROLL CALL

The Employment Bureau solves many of your "help" problems. Phone 765.



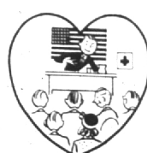
The Welfare activities of the House provides real "distress" service.
