**U. S. Preparations Better Than 1917**

Outbreak of shooting war in the Pacific found the United States better prepared than it had ever been before at the opening of hostilities, it is reported by James Free, in the Chicago Sun.

The Navy, which had only about 60,000 men when this country entered the World War according to the Sun, now has 311,861. And Secretary Knox asserted recently that "on any comparable basis the United States Navy is second only to the Navy of the United Kingdom."

before has this country been engaged in a two-year war and never before have so many sources of the nation's sugar been in jeopardy, no every pound that was produced in Michigan means one less pound that will have to be shipped in from Cuba and the Central and South America.

It has so happened that Michigan's twelve sugar factories have truly stepped in the breach with the 302,000,000 pound output. Last spring sugar beet acreage was cut 17 per cent from 1940, but despite this the 1941 crop produced only 10 per cent less sugar than in 1940. Part of the credit undoubtedly should go to the weather, but as sugar men see it, a good deal should also go to the efficient sugar beet growing. Yields per acre were highest in the history of the state, reaching 10.6 tons by the latest government preliminary estimate, which is conservative. Only three years in the past have approached this. 10.3 tons per acre were grown in 1917, and in 1931 and 1932 when weather conditions were far more favorable. Then, after the 1941 harvest season was the wettest in years, but efficient beet handling resulted in less abandonment and loss of beet tops than normally occurs.
