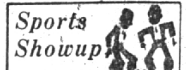


Thinclads Defeat Pontiac High 60-44 In Meet Tuesday

 Backing up their seventh consecutive victory by downing Pontiac 60 to 44, Tuesday afternoon at Pierce Field, the Birmingham thinclads are earnestly preparing for the district regional which will be held Saturday at Ypsilanti.

Peterson, Birmingham, won the broad jump with a leap of 19 feet 4 inches in the presence of Armstrong who suffered a knee injury in the Dearborn-Wayne meet. Armstrong was the Maples' chief point-winner in the broad jump and hurdler. Barger of Pontiac was second and Frank Watts of the Maroons was third.

The locals' speedy relay team of Sterling, Kaarsberg, Peterson, and Steelman won in its usual manner in the fast time of 1:22 for an unofficial distance.

Just recovered from a recent illness, Kaarsberg of the Maroons, showed his usual form in the 440 yard run when he placed in front of Eastman, Pontiac, and Stewart of Birmingham.
