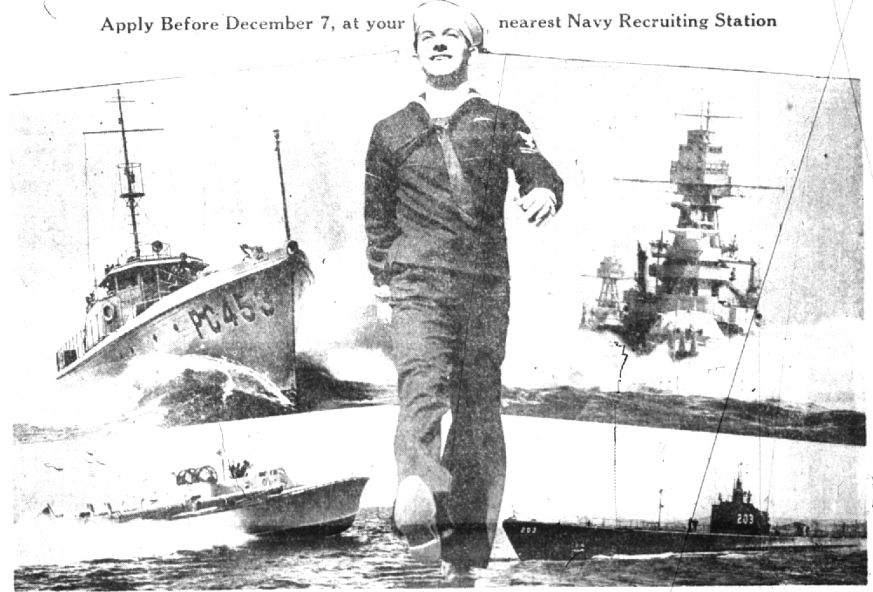

Responsibility for enrollment of men in the Merchant Marine rests with the Navy Recruiting Service. If you wish to sign up for this thrilling branch of our naval forces call at either of the Oakland County Recruiting Substations and you can quickly obtain all the details, including preliminary physical examination.

Pay in the Merchant Marine is as high as \$230 to \$300 per month to men on active sea duty. Three month's preliminary training qualifies you for such a high-paying job.
