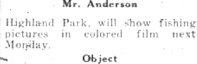


Not All Mothers Wanted to Work, Says Detroit Man

The new developments, odd doings, and recreational pastimes are subjects of the conversation of fellows around the round wood and cracker-barrel.

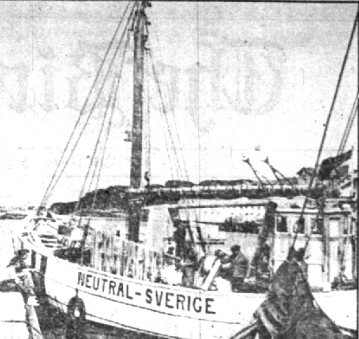
