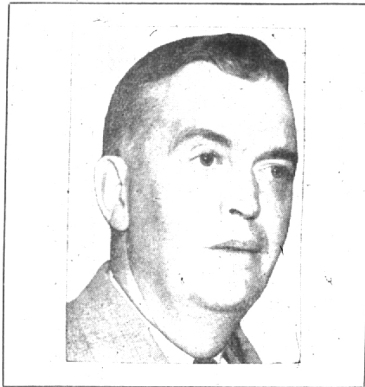

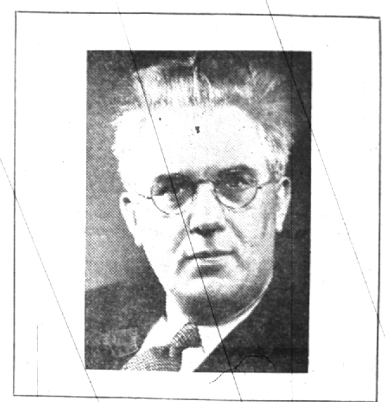
HARRY F. KELLY

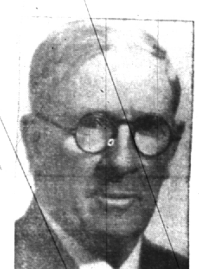

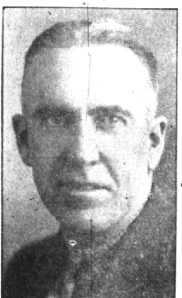
VERNON J. BROWN
