**Civilian Defense News**  
M. L. Kuykendall, of Hollywood boulevard, commander in chief of civilian defense of Southfield Township, reports that Mrs. E. K. Schadt, of Beverly Hills, who is a certified air raid warden instructor, will resume teaching air raid precaution this fall after a prolonged illness which kept her from activities the past few months.

Mr. Kuykendall said that Southfield Township lacks women wardens in daylight raids. Mrs. Schadt will hold classes at centralized points convenient to all; the dates will be announced later.

Mr. Kuykendall also stated there is a need for more instructors, and with that thought in mind he appointed Richard Newman, of Macnolia avenue, Mr. Newman was sent to Purdue University where he spent ten days taking the instructors' course. He is about to begin teaching soon, thereby giving Southfield Township a class of certified instructors in protective services.

**Can Install Phones Temporarily**  
The Michigan Bell Telephone Company today announced a plan to install new service on a temporary basis for civilians in certain areas where installations have been restricted sharply because of the war.

George M. Welch, president of the company, said that applicants for new installations in the restricted areas are being offered contracts which permit the company to withdraw service on a 48-hour notice, in the event the facilities required for the direct work effort or for the "public health, welfare, or security."
