GARDEN FOR VICTORY Now's A Good Time To Make Your Plans

April 3 Closing Date for Gardens

Let us take the hoe in hand, turnip the soil of our Victory Garden, and help to beat the Axis. This advice is a few weeks premature but there are things you should have done in preparation for your garden and there are definite things for you to do now.

Stake the Tract First of all you must stake the tract to be plowed. Use good-sized stakes and the bits of cloth on them. If a tractor is to be used you must allow 15 feet on the ends of the plot and 5 feet on the sides for manipulation of the machinery.
