

Recipes for Your Books, Cooks!

As eggs probably will become one of the most widely used substitutes for meat, you probably are balking up a file of new ways to prepare them. This is a recipe you will want to use again and again:

Eggs Yorkshire

2 eggs, beaten
1 cup milk
1 cup sifted cake flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/3 cup of butter or margarine, melted

Plain Pie Pastry

Mix in bowl—
2 cups sifted all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon salt
Work in—
1/2 cup lard or 2/3 cup vegetable fat.

Use two knives, a pastry blender or the tips of the fingers. Do this lightly and deftly so fat does not melt into the flour. When fat and flour are in particles about the size of small beans, add gradually—
3/4 cup water or just enough to make a stiff dough.

Mix only until a smooth dough is formed. Divide dough in half, then roll each half to 1/4 inch in thickness for upper and lower crusts. Fold one sheet of pastry in half, then roll into pie plate and trim edges. Roll upper crust in half, then make three slits, 1/2 inch in length, in center of folded side. Moisten edges of lower crust with a little water, fill with desired filling, then place upper crust in position. Trim, leaving one inch on all sides. Carefully fold and press down upper crust under lower crust all around the edge. Pinch to meet in center. Shape with finger tips or tines of a fork. (1 double or 2 single 9-inch crusts.)

Butter Doubler

Butter extenders are becoming popular. Here's a thrifty, homestyle way to stretch a pound of butter into a large bowl cut—1 pound butter.

Keep at room temperature to soften, but not to melt. Heat to luke warm—
1 large can evaporated milk.
Add 1 teaspoon salt.
Add milk mixture to butter and beat with wooden spoon until milk and butter are well blended. Shape by hand or press in mold and chill.

Stretching Sandwich Butter

A little butter may be made to go a longer way by stretching about time with sandwich filling. Two-thirds less butter is used by this method than when spread in separate layers.

Let ingredients stand at room temperature until softened, but not melted. Mix in large bowl with wooden spoon until well creamed. Spread on bread. Leftover butter may be stored in the refrigerator to use later for hot breads, toast, muffins, waffles, pancakes. Here are proportions to use for stretching:

- 1/2 cup butter + 1/2 cup honey = spread for 14 to 16 slices bread.
- 1/2 cup butter + 1/2 cup jelly = spread for 14 to 16 slices bread.
- 1/2 cup butter + 1/2 cup peanut butter = spread for 14 to 16 slices bread.
- 1/2 cup butter + 1/2 tablespoons prepared yellow mustard = spread for 8 to 10 slices bread.
- 1/2 cup butter + 1/2 cup apple butter = spread for 12 to 14 slices bread.

Raisin Pie, Oh My!

A dessert rich enough to satisfy the most cultivated sweet tooth is raisin pie. Old-fashioned raisin pie. The kind our grandmothers baked, back in the days when folks were neighborly... when a wedding, a birth, a visit, an illness brought offers of help and baskets of food from friendly folks in town.

Raisin Pie

In—
3/4 cups water
2 eggs over night
100 seedless raisins
1/2 cup milk
When ready to make pie add—
2 teaspoons lemon juice
1/2 cup sugar
2 teaspoons pure cider vinegar
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup butter
1/2 cup ground cloves
1/2 Simmer slowly about 15 minutes.
Add, stirring constantly—
6 tablespoons sugar (not necessary, but nice)
2 1/2 tablespoons cornstarch
2 Continue cooking until mixture thickens.
Line a 9-inch pie tin with pastry (recipe below). Pour fruit mixture
