The extremely heavy infestation of corn borers in Michigan this year will prove one handicap that Victory Gardeners will find hard to overcome.

There is still time to save at least part of the late crops by dusting or spraying with rotenone. It should be applied before the corn tassels out, if possible.

(Editor's note—Another important pest in the corn is the corn ear worm. Control measures include cutting off the tip of the ear as soon as the silk begins to dry up.

Potatoes Potatoes should be sprayed throughout the growing season with Bordeaux mixture and calcium arsenate or lead arsenate.

Bean Beetles Mexican bean beetles are putting in their appearance on green bean plantings in many sections.

Cucumber Wilt Be on the lookout for cucumber wilt, which we have already seen in many gardens.
