Military Chance For Disqualified Men

Men who have been disqualified for regular military service may still be able to get into the form, the Selective Service office here revealed Wednesday. If their classification is not too low, men who can type 40 words per minute or who have some other skill may be permitted to enlist in the U. S. Maritime Service for service within the borders of the United States. Inquiries may be made with the Maritime Service office, Hammond Building, Detroit. Age limits are 17 1/2 to 50.
