While Federal Debt Soars and Soars, Local Governments Reduce Theirs

By GENE ALLEMAN Michigan Press Association... State Treasurer D. Hale Brack recently computed the debts of Michigan local governments and reported the results in a news item.

Governmental indebtedness decreased \$67,000,000 between June 30, 1942, and June 30, 1943. In seven years local governments have paid off approximately \$100,000,000. Out of \$28 million dollar 1 0 U's existing one year ago, 455 millions were in Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties.
