Recreational Board Urges Skaters Keep Rinks Clean and Safe

Mrs. J. R. Quinn, chairman of the Birmingham Recreation Board this week called attention of skaters and other young folk and children using the various rinks and playgrounds, to the rules governing use of the recreation spots and urged that these rules be lived up to at all times.

Starting, she said, has been the most popular sport in Birmingham all winter. The weather has been ideal and ice conditions good. The crowds have, for the most part, been orderly and there have been few accidents. However, every now and then there are cases of violation of the rules and often these violations bring dangers to the younger skaters.

The following rules have been provided by the board:

Rules for the Skating rinks: Skates are a great hazard on the rinks both for the children riding them and for the skaters themselves. The skates are forbidden on the rinks.

The smaller rinks are built especially for the younger children. Therefore, in order that the younger children may skate with safety, no hockey will be allowed on the rinks at Rivenoak or at Pierce Field.

Hockey may be played on the South half of Quanton Lake at any time. Smaller children and other skaters should stay off of this part of the lake.

Hockey may be played at Torrey Field after 7 p. m. By order of the Recreation Board.

Exhibit At Cranbrook Institute Of Science, Bloomfield Hills, Aimed To Promote Better Racial Understanding



Here is one of the twenty-five important displays brought together as "The Races of Mankind" which is open to the public beginning Saturday, Jan. 22, at the Cranbrook Institute of Science, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan. The above display shows comparative skull structure of the various races and civilizations and indicates that no race is mentally superior.

Twenty-five displays of comparative inter-racial and intercultural development have been completed by the Cranbrook Institute of Science, Bloomfield Hills, and grouped together in an exhibition known as "The Races of Mankind" which will be open to the public for one month beginning Saturday, January 22nd, according to Dr. Robert T. Hatt, director.



The exhibition is described by Dr. Hatt as "the races of mankind in cultural, because 'the lines of cleavage in human society are due more to cultural than to racial differences.'"

The exhibition was brought together by John Adams, anthropologist of Columbia University, under the direction of Dr. Robert T. Hatt, and the advice of Dr. Ralph Linton of Columbia, Dr. Harry Shapiro of the American Museum of Natural History, Dr. Carl Guthe of the University of Michigan, Dr. Gene Weltfish of Columbia, and numerous others interested in anthropology and education.

The exhibition is strictly scientific in its approach there is no attempt to examine or analyze the human factors and prejudices which play such an important part in racial differences.

Approximately 32,000 white pines and 14,000 Norway spruces were planted on sandy ridges and 7,000 white spruces, 5,000 black spruces and 9,000 white cedars were set out on wet slopes and lower ground. More than 42,000 fruit and nut trees were planted on the sandy ridges in the same area but their survival is lower than the conifers.
