Further Facts Regarding the Proposed City of Birmingham Employees Retirement Plan

This series of advertisements has been authorized by the Birmingham City Commission and will be paid for from City funds to acquaint the electors of Birmingham with the proposed City Employees Retirement Plan.

The Plan will be presented to the city electors at the April 3, 1944, election, and will be voted on as an amendment to the city charter. A majority vote is required for the amendment to be adopted.

Copies of the proposed charter amendment will be available on March 23, 1944, at the Municipal Building and may be obtained there without charge.

What will be the benefits of the Plan if adopted? It provides an orderly method of replacing employees when they lose efficiency due to age at a cost to the City of only about one quarter of what it would cost to retain them on the payroll during their period of decreasing efficiency.
