Further Facts Regarding the Proposed City of Birmingham Employees Retirement Plan

This series of advertisements has been authorized by the Birmingham City Commission and will be paid for from City funds to acquaint the electors of Birmingham with the proposed City Employees Retirement Plan.

The Plan will be presented to the city electors at the April 3, 1944, election, and will be voted on as an amendment to the city charter.

Copies of the proposed charter amendment will be available on March 23, 1944, at the Municipal Building and may be obtained there without charge.

What will the Plan cost? The Actuary estimates that the Plan presented will cost an average of 8.48% of the payroll.

One of the reasons for the low cost of the administered Plan is that, as before stated, a large number of employees, in addition to those leaving to enter the armed forces, have left City employment during the last 3 1/2 years.

Careful preliminary estimates of the 1944/5 budget and assessment indicate that the adoption of the Plan will not make an increase of the tax rate necessary.
