

Donald Dickson Sings First Concert to Open Detroit Town Hall

Donald Dickson, young baritone of opera, concert, and radio, will open the Detroit Town Hall season at the Fisher Theatre Wednesday morning, Oct. 11, at 11 o'clock.

The first attraction in a series of 20 Wednesday mornings of lectures, music, and entertainment, the singer will give a varied program in five song groups, ranging from the classics to the American ballads and cypress tunes. He will be accompanied by Lawrence Stevens at the piano. The accompanist will have a solo spot on the program, playing selections by Schubert, Tcherpnine, and Dohnanyi.

In the first half of the recital Dickson will sing eight songs including the lovely "Where's Your Walk," "Praise Be to Thee"; Handel; Debussy's "Rite of Spring"; "I Hear America Singing"; Massenet's "Porgue et Me Reveille"; and "Nemico Della Patria" from Andreo Chénier.

The last half, following intermission will consist of five songs including "Sing Me" song, "In the Wood of the Hills of Tatra"; "The O'er" and a group of ballads among them "Don't Ask Me Lawd," "Hundred," "Wagner," and "I Call Me No More."

thority always has a good text. Our text today is found in 1 Samuel 30:24—"as his share is that which he has gained in the battle, so shall his share be that which he has gained in the battle; they shall share alike." The background of this text reflects the circumstances of our present time in many ways. The Amaliks had made a sudden, unprovoked attack on southern Judah. The marauding Amaliks burned houses, destroyed the fruit of the land and carried women and children into captivity. As David's men pursued the invading Vandals two hundred of his men gave out. They were so tired that David ordered them to stay behind and guard the baggage while the other 400 proceeded to rescue their loved ones and liberate their land. The battle was brief and the victory was complete. The story of victory was debauched by one single factor. Some of the men who went to battle complained against the fellow who stayed behind saying we will not give them aught of the spoil that we have recovered. David was a great leader and statesman, and when he heard of this he was grieved. He said in the words that we have chosen for our text "as his share is that which he has gained in the battle, so shall his share be that which he has gained in the battle."

When David insisted that those who fight on the home front should share equally the rewards of victory he implied that those who share in responsibility was likewise equal.

Special Food Packs Go from Red Cross to U.S. Kiddies Overseas

Oakland county people may be started to realize that American children are in German internment camps but this fact is emphasized by the announcement that American Red Cross is supplying special food to help them grow strong and healthy. Judge H. Russell, chairman of the Oakland County Red Cross chapter announced this week.

"Citizens of Oakland county should be happy to know that their contributions are helping to bring a balanced diet to the boys and girls who are civilian internees along with their parents," Judge Holland declared. To meet their nutritional need, the American Red Cross has designed a special infant's food package, shipped regularly through the International Red Cross committee.

The package includes two two-pound tins of whole milk powder, five bars of soap, seven pairs of vitamins A and B, a package of cereal, tins of spinach, carrots and peas, a tin of applesauce, liver soup with vegetables, custard pudding, apricots, prunes, concentrated orange juice, concentrated grape juice, a tin of granulated sugar and a tube of absorbent paper.

Other packages supplied weekly by the American Red Cross for prisoners and internees are the standard food packages. The valid food package, a medical kit containing first aid supplies sufficient for two prisoners for a month, the capture parcel of clothes and personal items for newly liberated prisoners and a Christmas parcel containing holiday foods and gifts.
