


**ORDINANCE NUMBER 315**

**CITY OF BIRMINGHAM**  
AMENDMENT TO BUILDING CODE ORDINANCE  
An Ordinance to Amend Section 12-261, Part 1 of Ordinance No. 184, of Birmingham, Alabama. This Section 12-261, Part 1, of Ordinance No. 184 (Building Code) be amended to read as follows:

Private garages and other accessory buildings of frame construction on the same lot with a dwelling shall not be more than 3 feet from the side and rear lot lines and 10 feet from the street line. Where there is no street line or side of any lot a private garage may be situated on a south lot line but not project beyond the alley line. If any portion of such private garage is within 10 feet of the dwelling it shall conform to the requirements for attached garages. (See Sec. 12-262 (f).)
