**THE ECCENTRIC'S Camera Corner**

Informal portraits are usually most effective if you get as close to your subject as possible. But it is sometimes desirable to get the entire head and shoulders in the picture.

School days are here again, and it's time to get a new camera for your more fun. No matter how much your young scholars complain about the nuisance of school, it isn't hard to see that even they find vacations a little longer than they thought, and actually they're happy to get back into routine living with a chance to work and compete with their friends.

One way to make school a memorable and happy occasion is to record it on film. The years go by so quickly, and it isn't long before the children who seem such babies today are off to college and then out into the world.

The snapshot shown above illustrates one method of making effective informal portraits without training the camera on your subjects from close ranges. In this case, the object was to capture not only the personality of the children and the nature of the event, but also something of the setting. This path through the park is filled with happy memories. It's a very important part of the life these children lead, and when they look back upon it years later, they will be thankful that you had the foresight to record it for them.

Snapshots of this type can often be made more effective by unusual lighting. In this instance, notice how the light comes toward the camera. This gives added depth and atmosphere to the photograph, making the individual foliage groups stand away from each other and creating a three-dimensional effect.

When shooting toward the light, however, two cautions are necessary. The first concerns the problem of keeping the light rays from falling directly into the camera lens with a consequent "blazing" of the snapshot. This can be avoided either by using an inexpensive lens hood or by shading the lens with your hat or hand. But be careful not to obstruct the lens, or you'll cut off part of the picture.

The second precaution concerns exposure. In order to get clear detail and luminosity in the shaded areas, especially if you are using a small lens aperture to gain depth of field, remember to increase the exposure time accordingly.
