NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

To City of Bloomfield Hills Zoning Ordinance

Public hearing will be held Tuesday, December 11, 1945 at 200 o'clock P.M. at the City Hall of the City of Bloomfield Hills, upon a proposed amendment to Section 17 Sub-Section 3 or Ordinatec No. 49, pertaining to the size of dwellings, to amend said Sub-Section to read as follows:

"IV. 3.—Size of Dwelling.—No private dwelling, excepting herefront those classified as accessory uses, shall be erected or attered in District A, which contains by volume less than 35,000 cibic feet. The cubical content or a building shall be compited from the exterior face of the walls and from the bottom of the basement floor, or, in the case of basementless buildings, from the bottom of the foundation but not lower than 3 feet is inches below grade, to the average height of the roof, including all permanently enclosed, and heated projections, bays, dormers and porches, but excluding unenclosed or semi-permanently enclosed proceedings, or projections of chimneys. The cubical content of attached garages shall not be included in the total required, volume of private dwellings, except that the cubical content of any living quarters in connection therewith and having direct access to such dwelling shall be included.
