Alien In The Service

Lt Forester Back After 50 Missions

MIAMI, Fla.—Returned from overseas via ATC airplane, four Michigan men today were clearing Air Transport Command's Miami Army Air Field enroute home. Lt. Warren C. Forester, 27, of 560 W. Brown street, Birmingham, has spent 10 ten months in Italy, where he has been pilot of a B-24 over such enemy targets as Vienna, Munich, Linz, Ploesti and Budapest. He has flown a total of 50 combat missions and his plane is credited with shooting down one enemy plane. His awards include the D.F.C. and the Air Medal with 10 oak leaf clusters. Lt. Forester is the son of Geo. W. Forester.

Capt. Peter Kok, 25, Zealand, has served 11 months in the European theatre and has just returned from Italy. A bombardier on a B-24 he has flown 67 combat missions and has been awarded the Purple Heart, Silver Star, the D.F.C. with cluster, and the Air Medal with 7 clusters.

Capt. Frank S. Day, 25, Detroit, served six months in the European theatre as a pilot of a B-24. He completed 60 combat missions. He wears the Air Medal with three clusters and the D.F.C. He has served 10½ months in the Pacific and the C.B.I. theatre. As an engineer on a B-24 he was shot down on an combat mission and has been awarded the Air Medal.

Pfc. Buckridge served six months in the Caribbean area early in 1943; returned with his battalion in September of that year; shipped out of the United States in April, 1944, for North Africa; was stationed in Italy until Aug. 15. That day Pfc. Buckridge engaged in his first battle with the Nazis when his glider unit flew with the invading air fleet into Southern France and captured a town from the Germans. Then, after duty at or near the front for some time, he was sent to a rest camp just prior to being shipped to England.

Pfc. Buckridge won his first sash stripe on Aug. 15, D-Day, and shortly afterward the combat medal, which he has sent home to his parents.
