

Introductory Bible Lectures To Be Given At Community House

Arrangements have been made whereby the Rev. Harold P. Cornell of this city will give a series of ten weekly introductory Bible lectures in the Community House starting Monday, November 12, 8 to 10 p.m.

In general, the course covers the history of, and the history in the Bible. Special attention is given to all the outstanding Bible events and characters in their historical order from Genesis to Revelation.

Printed notes with maps will be furnished with most of the lectures and personal notes may be taken if desired.

Those who have previously attended this series will find it refreshing with a new approach, and several new subjects.

The lecturer, who is an ordained minister, is a graduate of the Bible College of Chicago with two additional years of study at the Pittsburgh Seminary, Pittsburgh. This early training, together with years of Bible study as a pastor, has here recently been supplemented by the study of a wide range of Bible subjects in the preparation of this particular series of Bible Lectures.
