Economics and was given an M.A. degree at Columbia University in 1912.  
After a few months with Bankers Trust Co. of New York City he entered the employ of the Ford Motor Co., and remained with them until World War I, when he was commissioned a lieutenant in the Air Force. After his discharge in 1919, with the rank of captain, Mr. Roberts became connected with the Motor Bankers Corp. of Detroit and served as president until his resignation because of ill health.  
He later formed the firm of McDonald-Robbins and remained associated with T. C. McDonald until 1945, when illness forced him to retire. With his wife, Claytie Widener Roberts, whom he married Oct. 15, 1922, he spent the last two winters in Pasadena, Calif.

Mr. Roberts was a member of Psi Upsilon fraternity, the Detroit Athletic Club, and he was a charter member of Orchard Lake Country Club.

Besides his wife and parents, he is survived by a sister, Frederika Robbins of West Hollywood, Calif., and a brother, E. Rawson Robbins of Pasadena.

Services were held Tuesday, April 9, at 11 a. m. at the Turner and Stevens Mortuary in Pasadena and burial was in San Gabriel cemetery, Pasadena.
